

Labuan MP Rozman lodges police report against news portal

LABUAN: Labuan Member of Parliament, Datuk Rozman Isli on Tuesday lodged a police report against Sabah-based news portal, Sabahkini2.com for publishing an allegedly defamatory report on Monday which damaged his reputation.

He said the report, with the headline 'Rozman MP Labuan

keluar Warisan serta Muhyiddin?', had gone viral on social media and created confusion and unnecessary speculation among many Parti Warisan Sabah (Warisan) leaders.

Rozman said the report was published not long before Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin unveiled his

new Cabinet in Putrajaya on Monday.

"I have already lodged a police report against the news blog to demand an open apology over its defamatory report," he told a press conference here Tuesday.

"I strongly deny the Sabahkini2 report which has

damaged my reputation.

"I will stick to Warisan and am prepared to be an opposition MP to voice out the rights of Labuan and Sabah," he said.

Rozman said he was considering whether to take legal action against the news portal. – Bernama
